Instructions to Presiding Officer/Voters

- 1 Please ensure free and fair polling in each constituency.
 - 2 Date of Election 9.01.2016(11a.m to 4 p.m)and Date of Counting of Votes is 16.01.2016
 - 3 Voters who were transferred within the interim period of election, can cast their vote in either the constituency where his/her name is enrolled in the voter list, or, in the new constituency where he/she has joined, provided the presiding officer of the latter constituency records it and sends a note to the election commission to this regard.
 - 4 Voters whose name appears more than once in the electoral roll can vote once in any of the constituency where his/her name is enrolled. His/her name appearing in the electoral roll of the other constituency/same constituency, where he/she has not voted would stand automatically cancelled.
 - 5 Presiding officers should verify the names of the voters from Electoral Roll and maintain a record of the voter's signature before they are allowed to vote.
 - 6 Presiding officer should maintain a record of number of ballot papers allotted/used ballot paper/unused ballot paper/cancelled ballot paper/valid ballot-in his/her constituency, which he/she should send it along with the valid ballot papers in sealed envelope.
 - 7 The valid ballot papers should be sent in a sealed envelope to the Election Commission by 14th January, 2016.
 - 8 Presiding officers are instructed to allow retired teachers to cast their votes in any constituency, provided his/her name should be enlisted in the Electoral Roll Sheet.
 - 9 Presiding officers are instructed to allow voters of the hill colleges (Darjeeling Govt College and Pedong Govt. College) to cast their votes in the respective college or at the booth of nearest constituency including the Association office booth, provided their names are enlisted in the Electoral Roll Sheet. Presiding officers are to put the signature of voters of said college in their personal diary.
 - 10 Voters of Dinhata Physical Education College will cast their votes at A.B.N.C.L college booth, Coochbehar.

- 12 Voters of Sister Nivedita College (Hasting House) and State institution of Physical Education (Alipore) will cast their vote at Sister Nivedita College.(Hasting House)
- 13 Voters of Govt institute of Physical Education (Banipur) will cast their vote at Govt College of Education.(Banipur)
- 14 Voters of Jhargram Raj College and Jhargram Raj College Women Wings Will cast their votes at constituency of Jhargram Raj College.
- 15 Voters of Govt College of Engg and Tech. , Beharampur will cast their votes at their nearest constituency or central Booth
- 16 Voters of Govt College Of Engg and Ceramic Tech , Beliaghata will cast their votes at Constotucy of Moulana Azad College
